City Year is a national service organization calling on young Americans to act on their idealism by dedicating a year of their life to full-time service to their community and country. City Year corps members, ages 17 to 24, unite from across all backgrounds to participate in service to New Hampshire schools and communities. City Year is a public/private partnership funded by corporations, foundations, individuals, and AmeriCorps.

In collaboration with community partners, City Year supports the positive, healthy development of youth through the experience of service learning and civic engagement, so that they grow up as confident, compassionate, and active citizens.

BIG BROTHERS/ BIG SISTERS MENTORING

Each City Year member has an opportunity to mentor a student through the Big Brothers/ Big Sisters program. During their weekly meetings together the eight students and corps members will play games, talk and develop positive relationships.

ENGLISH LANGUAGE LEARNERS

City Year corps members provide in-class support to the four ELL classrooms. Corps members also design and deliver themed workshops once a week which will help students develop their social skills, their ability to work on a team as well as promote and accept diversity.

LUNCH TIME PROGRAMMING

The City Year Lunch clubs are a program for all Hillside sixth grade students. Twice a week student representatives from all sixth grade teams participate in fun, interactive workshops. The activities promote social skills, confidence, cooperation and acceptance amongst students.

READING ROOM

Students spend one hour a week (20 minutes/ 3 days a week) participating in literacy activities with Corps members. Students receive individual support while working on Lexia, a phonics based computer program, reading aloud or participating in Science Reading Association (SRA) a collection of leveled stories and activities. A total of twenty-two students are serviced through this program.

21ST CENTURY COMMUNITY LEARNING PROGRAM

At Hillside, City Year is participating with the Manchester School District's 21st Century Community Learning Center program providing after school enrichment. The workshops are offered twice a week focusing on social change through art. Students will have exposure to a variety of art media, discuss and address relevant social issues, and participate in community service projects.
